

- ✓ ITIL 4 will evolve to provide an end-to-end IT/Digital Operating Model


ITIL 4 - New certification scheme



- ✓ Clearer career path for professionals from Foundation to higher levels
- ✓ 2 different streams:
 - ITIL Managing Professional (ITIL MP)
 - ITIL Strategic Leader (ITIL SL)
- ✓ Phasing out: Earliest ITIL v3 discontinuation is June 2020

ITIL 4 – Transition to new certification scheme

- ✓ No Bridge exam for Foundation
- ✓ Transition module for ITIL Managing Professional: a certified training course and exam that enables ITIL v3 (2011 edition) certified professionals to transition to ITIL 4
- ✓ Pre-requisites:
 - o ITIL Expert (v3) certificate, or
 - a minimum of 17 credits from the Foundation and Intermediate/Practitioner modules

Is there a Foundation Bridge?

No, interested candidates need to take ITIL 4 Foundation

When will ITIL v3 be discontinued?

The earliest that ITIL v3 will be discontinued is June 2020, but we will confirm the final date wit at least 6-month warning

What about translations?

ItSMF Hungary will support the translation of the glossary and the tests, the translation date is to be agreed

What has happened to ITIL Practitioner?

It's not in the scheme as a separate designation, but its content is available throughout the scheme; e.g. the guiding principles are already mentioned in ITIL 4 Foundation

What does ITIL 4 Foundation exam look like?

It is a closed book 40 multiple question exam, Bloom's Level 1 & 2, pass mark: 65%; info available on the syllabus

Will training be mandatory?

Not for Foundation, only for higher modules; more info to be provided in Q1 2019
